

In June, Joann Baucom, who was director of residential services for the last 25 years, retired. I personally as well as LSM will always be grateful for her unwavering dedication to our residents and ministry!

One of LSM's guiding principles is giving back to the community that whole-heartedly supports us. 

utheran Sunset has long recognized the need for providing their residents with opportunities in the four key aspects of successful aging – intellectual, spiritual, mental and physical. "Through our partnership with Masterpiece Living, a multi-specialty group who is committed to older adults aging in a better way, we've adopted the

successful aging philosophy," says Andrea Hikel, Rainbow Retirement Community manager. "Through our residents' Lifestyle Reviews, we've seen a decrease in loneliness and an increase in social and physical activity. This tells us we are on the right track."

With these stats in mind, LSM decided it was time to offer the same enriching opportunities they provide their residents to the community at large. After brainstorming, some research, and visiting café's with similar models, it was approved in 2016 by the Board of Directors to pursue the idea of Windmill Café.

More than a café, Windmill will not only offer gourmet dining to the Clifton Community, but will offer programming for those who are 55 or better. This programming will include opportunities such as educational speakers, art classes, exercise classes, computer basics, health fairs and more. "The opportunities are endless," says Mrs. Hikel. "If it's a topic that older adults are interested in, we will try to incorporate it at some point in time. Suggestions are always welcome."

In order to provide these interesting and enticing programs, Windmill Café has partnered with a fellow nonprofit, Enrich Seniors, who will have volunteers on sight to help lead programs and provide transportation for older adults in need in the Clifton community. Enrich Seniors is a nonprofit organization compassionately dedicated to improving the lives of seniors in our community through life-changing services and impactful programs. The exercise classes by Leah Miles, currently offered in the adjoining room, will continue as scheduled and will be incorporated into the café programming schedule. For those unfamiliar with the classes, Mrs. Miles offers three convenient class times of 8am (advanced), 10am (intermediate) and 11am (post rehab). Anyone in the community is invited to attend.

Mrs. Carrier has quite the following as she's the former owner of Gourmet Grill, which was located in Clifton. She brings 30 years of experience to the table, as well as her well sought after recipes. The Grand Opening of Windmill Café took place September 18, 2017. Residents of Clifton and surrounding communities were invited to meet the staff, sample entrees, participate in programming and attend a ribbon cutting with the Clifton Chamber of Commerce.


