

Message from the President

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

Here we are, beginning year three of the "new normal" living with COVID. It has been quite a ride since March 2020. I know we are all tired of it, but it is still here and we are adjusting. Omicron has had its run through the state of Texas, Bosque County, Clifton and LSM and we are now on the downhill side of it.



Due to all the precautions, only staff members have been sick with the Omicron version of COVID so far in Sunset Home and Heckmann Assisted Living. Thanks to the precautions taken by Lance Allen and his team at Sunset Home and Sabreena Geeslin and her team at Heckmann Assisted Living, neither of those residential programs has had a resident case of COVID. Rainbow Retirement has had a handful of resident cases, but those residents are out and about in the community so there's not a lot we can do to prevent infection except to encourage safe behavior when they go out or have visitors come to their apartments. Our staff are doing great things!

On a different note, I am pleased to let you know that last year LSM acquired more land along Avenue Q here in Clifton next to land we already owned, with the intent to add housing to our independent living program. We are in the process of getting the land that is not already in the city limits annexed. We have already met with the city to discuss water and sewer capacities for the additional housing and there is ample capacity available. We will be adding one- and two-bedroom single family homes and as well as some duplex housing. The annexation should be completed in February and then the civil engineering and geotech work can start so we can plat the property to get approved by the City of Clifton. Then, financing has to be in place, plans drawn and construction started. While that was quick to write, it will take some time to get done!

I know LSM has benefited from your prayers and support as we have navigated these turbulent times. Please continue to pray for us as we begin to recover from the impact of COVID and as we make new plans! As you pray, please ask God to send us more staff, as well as residents, so we can get back to a good financial footing.
